### Art

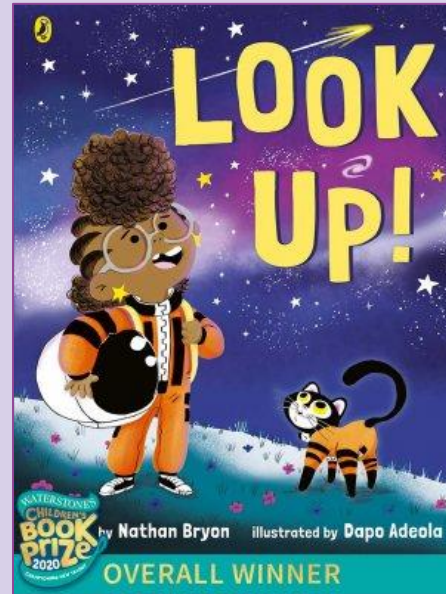
- Can you draw/design a creature that you might find in Space?
- Imagine you have been asked to design a new spacesuit for Rocket. Look at other spacesuit designs and then create your own - think about your favourite colours and patterns.
- Follow the illustrator's video on how to draw Rocket's cat.

### Design & Technology

- Rocket loves the idea of travelling to space. Can you research, design, make and test your own paper rocket?
- Get a large cardboard box and decorate it like Rocket does. Use different materials to decorate the box and think about the uses of the variety of materials.

### PSHE

- Rocket and her brother Jamal are very different. Describe the ways they are different. Think about the ways in which you are different/similar to your friends/family members. What makes you special?



### Music

- Rocket makes up a happy dance about the meteor shower. Have a go at making up your own happy dance!



### Maths

- This story takes place over a day. Make a plan of Rocket's day with the different activities and times? Draw the clock faces to draw when things happen.
- Look at different amounts of money and the coins we have. Think about the different prices of things and consider which coins you could use to make those amounts.
- Look at the night sky and count the stars you can see.

### Science

- Research the solar system and other things you find in the sky. Learn about the sun, moon and stars.
- Learn about meteor showers and constellations – exciting star collections we can see in the sky.

### Geography

- Rocket walks to the shops in the story. Can you think about walking to the shops? Draw a map of the route you need to take to the shop and then write directions to help someone getting to the shop.

### History

- Rocket wants to be an astronaut when she grows up. Can you research Mae Jemison's life or other female astronauts and write fact files about them?
- Can you research the history of space travel: when was the first time humans landed on the moon? Has anyone ever landed on other planets?
