Art


- Can you draw/design a creature that could survive in one of the locations in the story?
- Imagine you need to design a flag for your sky ship that tells people all about who you are. Think about the things that are important to you and design a flag.

Design & Technology

- The story is set on an island in the middle of nowhere. Can you design your own island?
- Ellie is an inventor. She is always inventing things. Can you invent something that would make your life/your parents' life/your teacher's life easier?


PSHE

- Secrets are being kept throughout the story. Is it ever OK to keep secrets? Are there some secrets we shouldn't keep?
- A lot of the story is based on fear of the unknown. Can you talk about the things you're scared of and find out what others are scared of?



Music

- Can you write your own sea shanty to teach to Seth as you travel in the submarine?



Maths

- The story starts with a young boy and a whale. Investigate the sizes of different animals and draw them in scaled diagrams.
- Have a go at drawing a map of the island based on what you learn about in the story.

Science

- Ellie distracts the authorities by using fireworks. How do they work? Can you learn about what makes fireworks the colours they are? What makes them bang?
- Learn about the water cycle and tides. What is a tide? How do they change?
- Ellie invents a submarine in the story – can you investigate how submarines work and how they've changed through time?

Geography

- The rest of the world in the story has been flooded. Can you investigate floods and other natural disasters (volcanic eruptions/earthquakes/tsunamis) and describe how they impact the world around them?

History

- Throughout history, many different cultures have worshipped a variety of different Gods. Can you research these beliefs and their Gods?
